3. Policy

4.1 CSR Vision

To generate a sustainable business model that balances the needs of all stakeholders with our commitment to improve access to healthcare and create long term sustainable impact on target beneficiaries / communities.

CSR will remain a fundamental part of our company's practices, broad objective and overall culture.

4.2 Governance structure

The Company has put in place the following governance structure to ensure that CSR policy is implemented and monitored effectively. The roles and responsibilities are defined at each governance level.



4.3 Target Audience of CSR activities

The Company, through its CSR interventions will try to contribute positively towards women and children. The Company will prefer to work with the most underprivileged section of the society. The Company will also engage its employees; wherever and whenever possible, to achieve its CSR vision.

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4.4 Support Focus

- Technology incubation Contribution of funds provided to technology incubators located wit academic institutions.
- 10). Rural development projects Any project meant for development of rural India.
- 11). Slum area development.
- 12). Disaster management, including relief, rehabilitation and reconstruction activities.

4.5 CSR Budget

A specific budget is allocated for CSR activities. This budget is project driven and is in line with the Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013. In case the Company fails to spend the targeted amount in that particular financial year, the Committee shall submit a report in writing to the Board of Directors, the reason for not spending the amount which in turn shall be reported by the Board of Directors in the Directors' Report for that particular financial year. Surplus arising out of the CSR initiatives shall not form a part of the business profits of the Company.

4.6 Modalities of implementation



Monitoring of Spending

CSR activities and correlating spends will be closely monitored and funds shall be released as per the approved work plans. This may include monthly field visits, comprehensive documentation, and regular interaction with beneficiary communities. Also, the CSR spends will be audited in an accountable and transparent manner.

The involved 3rd party providers will be requested to provide proper and regular monitoring, as agreed between Paramount Health Services & Insurance TPA Private Limited and them.

Evaluation

A robust MIS monitoring mechanism and evaluation plan will be put in place with expected outcomes, outputs and inputs will be clearly defined for each programme as per stated timelines.

4.7. Reporting and Communication Program Reporting and documentation

Program monitoring mechanism will ensure:

- The CSR Policy is implemented as per the Act and the Rules.
- The CSR Policy is implemented ensuring that all the projects/programs as budgeted are duly carried out.
- Quarterly reporting and review of CSR Committee of the Board and six monthly reviews by the Board.

Communication

The CSR Committee will prepare the annual CSR report with an approval of the Board of Directors. The company will be communicating its CSR efforts to its employees and external stakeholders through internal communications, its own website and other appropriate dissemination channels.
